- a. Whenever any pupil lives more than one and one-half (1 1/2) miles from any established bus stop, or from the school but at a greater distance from the nearest bus stop than from the school, and such pupil is regularly transported by private vehicle not under contact with the school district, the Board shall pay to the parent or guardian an amount per month not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle plus mileage at the current rate established by the State Board of Examiners for each round trip approved. The Board of Trustees may limit payment to one (1) private vehicle for one or more families.
- b. Whenever in the judgment of the Board of Trustees any pupil residing within the area of a non-transportation zone, and otherwise eligible to transportation, cannot be transported in any manner herein authorized, the said Board may pay to the parent or guardian thereof such amount of the cost incurred by the parent or guardian for the board and lodging of the pupil as may be authorized by the Board of Trustees.
